➤ **Page setup:**

Margins:

Top 1”
Bottom 1”

Paper Size A4
Justify Center
Line Spacing 1.5 lines

Header- Align left **Mangalore University Mangalagangothri** (Times new roman with a size 10, not bold / italics,)

Footer- left side **R.V.Center for Cognitive Technologies** right side your course (eg. MS-Mobile Communication & Internet Technologies)

The report has to have these in that order starting from the very 1st page (As soon as you open the hard bound report)

➤ **Front Sheet:**

The front page is the same that appears on the hard bound. No Page Number, no header/footer in this page. An OHP prior to this page.

➤ **Certificates:**

Two in number. 1st is the internal guide & Director. The 2nd is the external guide's. You may put OHPs before each of these if you wish. The external guide's certificate, contrary to popular option, is not important. If you are not able to procure one, or if your external guide is not in a position to sign it. No Page Number, no header/footer in this page.

➤ **Declaration:**

Say something like....I am the only one who worked on this original project etc. No Page Number, no header/footer in this page.

➤ **Abstract:**

Your report starts here with Header/footer and page number should be in Roman (I, II, III,....)and align it in the center.

➤ **Acknowledgement:**

This is where you thank all those people whom you've rarely (or never) met but whose inspiration, motivation, encouragement, blessings etc. etc. have helped you to write this immensely knowledgeable report & not thank your friend who did most of your coding. In this page contains Header/footer and page number should be in Roman and align it in the center.

- **Body of the Report:**
 1. This page starts with introduction and ends with Conclusion and Future Work. All pages should contains Header/footer with page number (1, 2, 3...) at the bottom of the page with align in the center.
 2. Contents should be in Times New Roman with a font size of 12. Headings should be in bold and size should be 14.
 3. At the end of each chapter you can insert a buffer sheet (Middle Page) with Chapter number and chapter name. Page number is not required in this page.

- **Authors Publication:**
- If you publish any papers in any conference you can insert the colour Xerox of your certificate. It is not necessary.

- **References:**
- The one you've referred in your report. Every item in your reference should have a citation in the body

- **Appendix:**
- Index, Glossary and others can put here. Also this is the place where you can put your data sheets circuit diagrams and other extreme stuff that don't fit in the body
